Subject: Release of 1st instalment of non-recurring Central assistance to State Government of West Bengal under the revised scheme of Teacher Education.

Sir,
 I am directed to refer to the Annual Work Plan received from the State Government of West Bengal for release of Central assistance under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education to West Bengal for the year 2012-13.

2. The Plan has been appraised and the following non-recurring Central assistance has been sanctioned for the year 2012-13 and its utilize in 2013-14 under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education in respect of West Bengal :

3. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the payment of Rs.113.21 lakh (Rupees One Crore Thirteen Lakh Twenty one Thousand only) to the Government of West Bengal as first instalment of non-recurring Central assistance for **General Head** for the year 2013-14 to meet expenditure on Civil works in the above mentioned under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education.

4. The above grant of Central assistance shall be subject to the following conditions:-

(i) Central assistance will be utilized in conformity with the guidelines for the scheme circulated to State Governments vide this Department's D.O. No. 44-2/2012-EE-9, dated 12-7-2012, and any other guidelines that may be circulated by the Deptt. from time to time

- (ii) Expenditure on the training programme under other specific schemes (like SSA, EGS / AIE, etc.), shall be met from the funds sanctioned under those schemes and not from the funds sanctioned under Teacher Education Scheme.
- (iii) A copy of every order of State Government according administrative approval or financial sanction for any item of recurring expenditure (including orders concerning posts) in connection with the above institutions will be endorsed to this Department.
- (iv) State Government shall abide by the terms & conditions of the MOU executed by the Ministry and the State Government, and any further guidelines which may be issued by the Ministry from time to time.
- (v) The amount of grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance out of the grant, if any, at the end of 2013-14, shall be refunded by the State Government after the close of the financial year, unless permission is granted for its being carried forward for utilization for the same purpose during the following financial year.
- (vi) State Govt. shall regularly submit half-yearly progress cum utilization report under the Teacher Education Scheme. Utilization report of amount being released by this sanction letter shall be forwarded by the State Govt. at the earliest, and in any case within three months from close of the financial year.
- (vii) Accounts of all grantee institutions shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority for audit whenever asked to do so.

5 Expenditure of Rs.113.21 lakh (Rupees One Crore Thirteen Lakh Twenty one Thousand only) will be debited to Demand No.59-Department of School Education and Literacy, Major Head 3601 Grants-in-aid to the State Governments, 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes, **188- General Head, -01-Strengthening of Teacher Training Institutions, 01.00.35-Grants for creation of capital assets General (Plan) 2013-2014.**

6. The pattern of grant/expenditure has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with rules and principles of the Scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.

7. On receipt of the sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur, for accrual of credit balance to the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the government of Punjab along with a copy to the undersigned.

8. The grantee is located in West Bengal Circle of Accounts.

9. This issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their Diary No. 2978/2013-IFD dated 27-5-2013 and IF-II Diary No.910/IF.II /2013 dated 11-6-2013.
